


Instructions to candidates

Maximum Marks: 100

Minimum Qualifying Marks: 50

3. Section II of the question paper contains 60 multiple choice questions of 01 mark each.
4. Candidates are required to shade the circle corresponding to correct answer in the OMR Sheet provided.
5. No marks will be deducted for the wrong answer.
6. The candidates are to write their roll nos. only in the space provided. Writing roll nos. in other spaces is strictly prohibited.
7. Any special remarks/sign/slogan may lead to cancellation of the candidature.
8. Candidates are required to go through the instructions thoroughly and are to follow the right spirit of the Test. Nonconforming with the instructions will be handled strictly.
